



## REACH Compliance Statement

Dear Valued Customer:

On June 1, 2007, the European Commission established new regulations (EC 1907/2006) that cover the Registration, Evaluation, and Authorization of Chemicals (REACH). The aim of REACH is to improve the protection of human health and the environment through the better and earlier identification of the intrinsic properties of chemical substances.

Based on the information currently available, the products Imperial provides to your organization meet the REACH criteria for an "Article", as opposed to a "Substance" or "Preparation". Articles are exempt from the REACH requirements if (a) the Article does not contain a substance of very high concern (SVHC) or candidate substance in an amount exceeding 0.1% weight by weight, and (b) if substances present in the Article in excess of 1 ton per year per importer are not expected nor intended to be released. Neither of these conditions applies to products or similar Articles manufactured by Imperial, based on the information provided to Imperial from its qualified suppliers.

All material that is procured from our qualified suppliers is based on the Bill of Material from our customers.

Please note: None of our materials were analyzed for content; we are working with and relying on component suppliers for material disclosure.
